About Walk Home 2017

Did you know there are an estimated 42,000 children experiencing homelessness in Massachusetts this year?

Homelessness is a family issue and is on the rise. You can help.

The 7th annual Walk Home 5K Benefit Walk for the Homeless will be on Sunday, June 11, 2017 at 10 am (rain or shine), at three locations – Danvers Rail Trail, Dorchester Park and Waltham Common.

Walk Home is sponsored by RTN Federal Credit Union and RTN GoodWorks Foundation. Funds raised help homeless teens and families. Donations may be tax-deductible. Since 2011, Walk Home has raised more than \$140,000.

Walk Home – our signature fundraising event – brings together RTN members and staff, community residents, business sponsors and local and state dignitaries and elected officials to work towards a common goal.

Walk Home funds are collected by RTN GoodWorks Foundation and donated to help homeless teens and

families in Danvers, Dorchester and Waltham, and support the work of Massachusetts Coalition for the Homeless (MCH). Students who participate in Walk Home may receive community service credit.

Here's how you can help homeless kids, teens, and families:

Walk

Lace up your walking shoes and take an active part in a Walk Home location near you. Set a fundraising goal that helps you raise funds and make a difference for homeless teens and families.

Sponsor a Walker

If you are not available to walk, you can support Walk Home 2017 by sponsoring someone who is walking.

Donate

You can make a direct donation to Walk Home 2017 without sponsoring a specific walker.

Volunteer

We can use your help for setting up, staffing the event and cleaning up at one of our three Walk Home locations.
